CAMERAS TO BE UP AND RUNNING FOR SEPT. 10th RACE.

Instant replay cameras are being put in place at Pueblo, Colorado's I-25 Speedway. The fast high-banked quarter mile paved oval track produces short track racing at its finest. One of the challenges of such fast-paced racing lies on the shoulders of the race officials to enforce the rules of racing.

In a statement made by track officials, "We have added a 6 camera instant replay system that focuses on every part of the racetrack as to be able to make clearer calls in questionable racing incidents. This will be functional starting Sept. 10th throughout the rest of the race season."

The reaction from competitors is optimistic and for the most part, a very welcomed improvement. Noting that "racing incidents" will always be in racing, track management is taking this proactive approach to better the experience for racers and spectators alike.
